

Welcome to a wild, powerful show - a journey through the straying universe of the human voice

'Everything starts with song. Hence comes my music.' Indeed, that is the artistic heartbeat for Gudrun Holck.

A concert with Gudrun Holck and her sevenpiece band is a groovy adventure for soul, eyes and feet. On stage her music is beautiful, sensual, humorous, touching, dangerous, crazy... Often beyond any known languages, she tells stories with her voice in a blend with ethnic world music, afro, folk, soul, and rock.

You can listen and let dreams take off. Or you can dance away to the energetic, swinging pulse. Gudrun Holck reaches audiences in all ages - from children and young people to grand parents - with a very original show and dance performance. Enjoy the journey into her world of singing, whispering, distortions, shouts, calls and live improvisations with a primeval force.

A great inspiration for Gudrun Holck, born 1971, comes from the African music as well as from her own Nordic roots. She lived in West Africa for four years and

dedicates her debut album 'Muse' to Fela Kuti, the Afrobeat musician who was her host and teacher for a year in Nigeria during the mid-1990's

'Muse' was released in June 2004. Since then Gudrun Holck has established a new band and re-arranged the songs from the album for a new set-up, now with drums, guitars, double-bass and bass guitar, accordion and backing vocals. And still with lots of percussion, marimba, and didgeridoo. The group has been touring Denmark on concert venues and festivals.

The song 'Cross The Stream' written to Gudrun Holck by the former Miles Davis percussionist Marilyn Mazur, and arranged by Gudrun herself, is nominated to the Danish World Music Award 2005.
